“We’ve grown Vistive™ low-lin soybeans for three years now – two years for seed production and commercially in 2007. We will plant 100 percent Vistive soybeans in 2008. There’s so much added value compared with traditional soybeans. Our Vistive soybeans this year averaged 58 bushels per acre, with some spots hitting 65 bushels. With the 60-cent-per-bushel premium, that’s \$36 per acre extra income for us. It’s a better soybean that helps make healthier food. In all the test plots I’ve seen, the Vistive soybeans have performed better yield-wise than all other conventional soybeans. These Vistive genetics are excellent.”
